Based on your facilities annual poundage and historical loss linen invoices Texas Textile will establish a penny per pound charge that will be invoiced to your facility weekly as a line item along with your weekly poundage invoice.

Texas Textile would like to meet with your facility's management/administration at your earliest convenience to review your individual hospital's historical annual linen loss invoices and present an addendum to our agreement extending the terms and conditions for payments of negative variance loss linen invoices.

Texas Textile feels that this Level Invoicing for loss linen will aid the hospital in budgeting and will eliminate fluctuation in loss linen invoices. There will be no additional finance charges for the extended terms.
